Students are required to study the material prior to attending the class.

Please bring your course material and your copy of the Liquid Fuels Handling Code 2007 with you. You may use the Liquid Fuels Handling Code during the exam.

Examination: The TSSA examination is included in your tuition (at no extra charge). The examination includes both practical and written components. The Practical component involves minor maintenance procedures on a fuel pump or dispenser. Students will receive notification of their theoretical exam mark in the mail by the TSSA within 3-6 weeks from date of exam.

Students must follow all exam rules that are posted in the classroom.

Certification: An applicant who successfully passes the examination (written and practical) is issued a Site Operator license by the Technical Standards & Safety Authority (TSSA). Applicants are notified by mail by the TSSA. The TSSA license fee is \$70.00 (renewable every two years). This fee is pre-paid with the course tuition and paid to TSSA on the student's behalf.
